# Foreword: "European Financial Literacy Game for Adults Citizens" (Euroinvestment project)

After two years of committed work, the <u>Euroinvestment project</u> has successfully completed all its activities, and the after-lifecycle plan has been set. During this long journey of experiences, lessons and challenges, the consortium has developed educational materials to foster low qualified adults' knowledge and competences about financial literacy. The project's implementation has contributed to improving the existing learning opportunities for adults to develop high-quality skills and competences on financial literacy.

#### **The Game**

We are proud to release the **Euroinvestment Game** in five languages (English, Portuguese, Spanish, Greek and Catalan), as a fun, interactive and didactic way to enhance adults' financial literacy skills. Access the Game <u>here</u>!

The Euroinvestment Game consists of 15 minigames about financial literacy topics which are divided into the following areas:

- Planning & Managing
- Money & Transactions
- Risk & Credit

By playing the mini-games, adults will be able to improve their financial literacy levels about concepts such as managing of their income and expenses, making better saving and borrowing decisions, being more likely to plan for retirement and holding more diverse assets in their balance sheet.

This game series in the area of Risk & Credit supports users in understanding the concept of credit, enabling them to make more responsible choices when they consider to save or borrow money.



The set of mini-games about Money & Transaction aims to help users to identify and understand business transactions using discounts, interest rates, perceiving taxes, and comprehend currency conversions.



The last mini-game series about Planning & Managing enables users to learn the basics of financial planning to ensure and achieve personal goals as a result of smart money management.

All the games can be used free of charge and as many times as needed.

#### **Workshops & Events**

The partners have also completed lately a series of workshops with adult educators and multiplier events to the wider public to disseminate the projects' activities in all partner countries. During the events, participants were introduced to the project's objectives, the game, and supporting material. Furthermore, they have been provided ways on how they can and should include the game and project's resources in their own courses or daily life. Generally, partners received positive feedback with notable comments regarding the utility and importance of such initiatives with (inter)national impact.



#### What's next?

Most of the project's activities and results will be maintained after the project ends, following one of the aims of the project, which is to produce and make available Open Access Educational Resources in multiple languages (Portuguese, Spanish, Greek and English). On this topic, it is important to refer that all the resources are also available in Catalan, under the IEF initiative to increase the mainstreaming and multiplication of the results among the end-users. The Euroinvestment games are the result with a higher potential for mainstreaming and multiplication. It consists of quality educational resources that can be used flexibly in adult education and other education areas.

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
